Lucio Fontana



Biography

Lucio Fortana is a European artist best known for his stashed canywses from his Text\(\text{/Cut}\) series. Born in America in 1899 to Italian immigrant parents, he spent his early life in Milan, where he attended school and later volunteered for the Italian Army during the his mother. Fontana clidn't consider himself to be either a painter or a sculptor, he was much more interested in light and space and wanted to be a "spatial artist". In from which emerged the "Manifesto blanco" (White writers and philosophers, he signed the "Primo manifesto dello spezialismo" (First manifesto of spatialism) and is considered the founder of the Spatialism art movement.

He spent the WWII years in Arpentina and when he returned to Milan, he found that his entire studio had been destroyed. He saw this as a new beginning, however, and in 1949 using a canvas for the first time in his career (at 50 years old), he had his great epiphery. created his most loople idea; the steel, his single clash which he called "attenta" mension walking or expectation, was a type of door towards infinity. During the 1958s. In the final years of his carear, Fortage became increasingly nomadic in his approach to mediums, and increasingly interested in the blurring of boundaries. He explored this in the staging of his work in the many exhibitions that boosted him worldwide. These concerns were prominent at the 1986 Venice. Biennale, for which he designed the environment for his work, and at the 1968 Documenta, Kassel, West Germany, Fontana died in September 1969 at the age

Despite working in a variety of mediums, with each bringing their own unique expect to Fontana's payress he remains best known for his starthed monochromatic painted canvases, better known as the Concetto spaziale works. Managem in Amsterdam Since 2884, more than 200 Fontana works sold at auction have surpassed the \$1 million rale price. Between 2007 and 2021, 207 of Fontana's paintings sold for \$883,4 million. In the same period, the value of comparable activories increased at a compound annual growth rate of 11.8% annually, according to Athena's analysis
